**Stadium Seats**

Attention All Parents and Students over the age of 14. Blessed Sacrament has an easy opportunity for you to earn Service hours and get into a Husker game for free.

You ask “How is that possible?” Easy, it is called Stadium Seats. All that is required is that you come to Blessed Sacrament 2 ½ hours before the game. There you will be taken to the Stadium. You will sell seats before the game. At game time you will be allowed to go wherever you want in the stadium. There are empty seats usually in the student section. At 6 minutes before the end of the game you report to the West Stadium. At the end of the game you will pick up the seats. This will take about an hour. You will then be given a ride back to Blessed Sacrament. You will earn 8 service hours per game which will give Blessed Sacrament 58 dollars per game per person. You can even pick your game. **Cafeteria Accounts**

Every student has a Cafeteria Account for breakfast (\$1.40), lunch (\$2.70), & milk (.50) purchases. You can fund their account by sending money to the office OR through myschoolbucks.com. If you choose to fund this account through myschoolbucks.com, please note that it MAY take 24 hours for your funds to appear in their student account. We ask that all families set up their students’ accounts so they can monitor them. Student accounts will “lock” them out when their accounts reach \$-5.40. As a courtesy, we check these accounts daily and will email when a student’s account will lock them out for the day. It is the parent’s responsibility to provide lunch/funds for their child. **Blessed Sacrament does not accept responsibility for providing lunches for children without funds.**

**7<sup>th</sup> Grade Physicals**

The Lincoln Diocesan Schools require a physical examination by a qualified physician within **six months** prior to the entrance of your child into the 7<sup>th</sup> grade. {cf. School Law 79-444(3) (1979)}. At this time, your physician may update your child’s immunizations if it is necessary. Failure to return this physical exam, or schedule an appointment by September 4<sup>th</sup> may jeopardize your child’s enrollment. We have several that have not yet turned their physical & immunizations into the office.
