Philosophy

Parents are the primary educators of their children. The goal of Blessed Sacrament School is to establish a Catholic environment for learning which supports the parents in the development of the whole child. We firmly believe that a child's potential can be determined by the foundation laid during the pre-school years. It is during this time that the child's character is developed by activities, experiences, personal interaction, and work which prepare him/her for effective living and learning. We pledge excellence in a Catholic environment.

Weather

We will follow regular grade school policy concerning weather announcements. Weather announcements reach all of us through the media. We advise you to keep tuned to the media for the closing of school or early dismissal due to bad weather. It is most important that you have arrangements made, however, if school is closed.

Attendance

Unless a child is ill, we expect regular attendance. To report absences, please phone the office at 476-6202 before 8:30 am. We ask that pre-kindergarteners be dropped off at the southeast door. Ring the bell for admittance. **It is essential that students be picked up promptly at 11:00 am.**

Birthdays

If you would like your child to celebrate his/her birthday at school, there are several options. We would like to establish a tradition of having the birthday child bring a book to pre-kindergarten which he/she would present to the class. The teacher would read the book, showing the children that the child's name and birthday are written in the front of the book and that it is his/her gift to the room. This encourages the value of books and also will help us build a pre-kindergarten library. Treats certainly may be brought. We would suggest things as: cupcakes, cookies, crackers, fruits, etc. If you wish to bring snacks or treats for other special occasions, Christmas, Valentine's Day and Easter, please let us know.

Illness

If a child is sick (sore throat, bad cold, temperature, fevers, coughing, diarrhea, etc.), keep them home for his/her protection as well as that of the other children. We will call you immediately if he/she becomes ill at school so that he/she can be picked up and taken home. We will not be able to provide the individual attention necessary for a sick child. If medication must be given to the child during pre-school, written authorization and instructions from the parent must accompany the medication. Medication must be in original packaging.

Cost

The registration fee for pre-kindergarten is \$25.00 and must accompany the registration form. The tuition is \$350.00 per month per child for Blessed Sacrament Parishioners and \$500.00 per month for non-parishioners and is due by the 20th of the month. You will receive a bill through email.
