Returning Student Enrollment will be selected for a student that has been enrolled previously in a Diocese of Lincoln Catholic School. New Student Enrollment will be selected for any student that has NOT been enrolled previously in a Diocese of Lincoln Catholic School (i.e PreSchool or Kindergartener that has not been in PreSchool). NEW '22-'23 POWERSCHOOL ENROLLMENT SYSTEM
