For the younger ones, I love seeing the absolute pride on parents' faces who are able to come to Mass, and I feel like I have a similar pride for every student who has the courage to stand up there and raise up petitions to God.

FACTS & GOOD SHEPHERD SCHOLARSHIP 2023-2024

Attached is information about the Good Shepherd Scholarship program for next year. This is a simple scholarship to receive, but you must apply to receive it! Families whose income level is below 225% of the federal poverty level or have more than 3 students enrolled in any Lincoln Diocese Catholic School (regardless of income) are eligible to receive the scholarship. You only have to apply.
