## **BLESSED SACRAMENT CATHOLIC SCHOOL 2025-2026 Tuition Agreement Statement**

The cost of educating each student at Blessed Sacrament School is approximately \$9,280. Blessed Sacrament's tuition rate is \$3,075 per student. Blessed Sacrament Parish provides a scholarship in the amount of \$6,205 per student for each child attending our grade school. Additional assistance for tuition may be available through the Good Shepherd Scholarship Program, as well as additional parish need-based scholarships, as defined below. The non-Catholic tuition rate is \$4,075. Families with more than three children in our K-12 school system are not asked to pay tuition for the fourth child (and subsequent children) if they notify the parish bookkeeper by June 1 before the following school year begins.

Families that have an income up to 225% of the federal poverty level qualify for the Good Shepherd Scholarship. Families that have an income up to 300% of the federal poverty level qualify for an additional Blessed Sacrament Scholarship. To obtain these scholarships, you must apply through the FACTS online program. Assistance to make this application is available upon request at the school. In addition, there are scholarships available from Blessed Sacrament Parish, depending on one's income.

## **FACTS Information**

Participation in FACTS is required for the Good Shepherd and the additional Blessed Sacrament Scholarships (not the fourth child nor the \$6,025 beginning scholarship). All applications must be completed by March 31, 2025. You are required to upload the tax and dependent forms to FACTS for verification of income. We can help families in completing the forms, which are located at www.goodshepherd scholarship.com. There is a \$35 FACTS application fee per family. FACTS is a third-party company used to evaluate applications to ensure the process is fair and financial data is secure and confidential.
