- FACTS Scholarship **must be completed by Mar. 31, 2026.**
- Families must submit the required tax documentation through FACTS to be considered.
- The Good Shepherd Scholarship covers families up to 225% of the Federal Poverty Level.
- Award amounts are \$1,800 for grades K–8 and \$2,100 for grades 9–12.
