Dear Blessed Sacrament Families,

Our school's advocacy is urgently needed now on school choice scholarship funding! Will you please write a letter to support families in need of education scholarships?

#### **What is being proposed?**

- Governor Jim Pillen has \$3.5 million for school choice scholarships in his proposed budget, awaiting approval from the Nebraska Legislature.
- These scholarships are intended to provide "gap assistance" funding for the 2026-27 school year for students who received school choice scholarships the last couple years. Check out [this impact report](#) to learn more about the students these scholarships helped.
- Next Tuesday (Mar. 17), the Legislature will vote on the proposed budget.

#### **What do we need from you?**

- Write a letter of support for students in need of life-changing education scholarships.
- **Return your letter to me before Tuesday (Mar. 17) morning at 9am.**

#### **What can you say?**

- Urge the Legislators to approve the budget with the \$3.5M School Choice Gap Assistance.
- Share your school choice story and why it matters to you.
- Emphasize that parents know what is best for their children's education and why we need to empower parents; school choice improves academic outcomes for all students in all school systems; school choice helps children out of poverty; or school choice programs are proven to save taxpayers money.
- When parents are empowered and students succeed, the whole state wins!
